PLAYER MILESTONES AND INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Games Tally

Team managers / coaches are required to establish the number of games played by individual players at the commencement of each season. A valuable source for this information is last year teambook.

Points to remember:

- Coaches end of year reports will require season games and total career games
- Milestone games can only be recognised if game tallies are recorded and are up to date
- Players transferring in should also be considered, games played at previous club/s etc
- EFL data on game tallies is patchy at best and should be used as a guide only
- EFL sanctioned Lightning Premierships count for 1 game
- Players playing up a grade to fill in after a game in a lower grade are also entitled to have an extra games added to their tally

Milestones

50 games - will be mentioned in EFL record & LJFC trophy

100 games - will be rewarded with EFL medallion & LJFC trophy

Team managers / coaches are to keep track of approaching milestone games and should consider the following:

- Liaise with parent to make banner
- Timing of home games V's away games and award / social nights
- Advise AWARDS CO ORDINATOR first thing Monday morning preceding the milestone game

Coach Awards

Medallions will be presented to player/s nominated by coaches in recognition of special achievements by players during the game. This is especially important in the lower age groups that all players receive a medallion at some stage throughout the season

At the commencement of the season a bulk order will be placed for player medallions based on the clubs registration list and retained by team managers for distribution during the season

Points to remember:

- It would be advisable to check all medallions for correct spelling
- Advise AWARDS COORDINATOR of players registering after the commencement of the season
- Coaches medallions will be presented immediately following the game

Team Awards

- 2nd Best and Fairest
- 3rd Best and Fairest

- 1st Team Award (name to be determined by team, most courageous, most improved etc)
- 2nd Team Award (name to be determined by team, most courageous, most improved etc)
